Considering the Agreement of Cooperation between Italy and Ukraine in the field of Defence, signed on the 17th March 1998, and in consideration of similar studies and researchers made by the two institutions and affinity of the objectives assigned to them, as well as of mutual interest to know opinions and views on various areas of analysis, and taking into account the tradition of close cooperation which link Italy and Ukraine in the matter of defence and security.

Having regard the Agreement between the Government of the Italian Republic and the Government of Ukraine on mutual protection of classified information, signed in Kiev on June 7th, 2001.

Considering that Ukraine is a membership of the Euro-Atlantic Partnership Council and has signed the PfP SOFA,

It's accepted as follows:

### **Paragraph 1**

The two parties accepted to keep each other informed about their research programs and studies carried out.

Information can be implemented through exchanges of letters and documents on paper or electronic format, direct contacts between the two parties.

## **Paragraph 2**

From the information exchanged, the two parties can identify, each year, a particular field of study which may be give way in a specific collaboration.

## **Paragraph 3**

The two parties accept to exchange invitations to events (conferences, seminars, symposium, ceremonies...) helping to promote the convergence between the two parties in accordance with their own missions and tasks.

## **Paragraph 4**

The two parties accept to consider the opportunity of conducting joint research activities (studies, publications and conferences)

## **Paragraph 5**

In compliance to the spirit of friendship and cooperation that this Technical Arrangement implies, each party carries out to give proper technical and cultural support, in accordance with the rules and regulations in force.

At the national and defense level, both parties exchange civil or military researchers, to carry out research of mutual interest.

In this regard, the host party will provide to the researcher an adequate work space and provide the possibility of access to the required documentation for the research development, in compliance, however, the constraints imposed by internal regulations.

For that, will be designated a representative of the host party to facilitate deal or necessary surveys.

All expenses concerning the presence of the researcher will be borne to the Institution belongs to. Special requests for logistic support (accommodation/Officers' club facilities) will be discussed and approved upon each case.

All activities carried out under this Technical Arrangement will be subject to the availability of funds of the Parties.

### Paragraph 6

As part of possible cooperation under Paragraph 4, one party cannot pass on any information, studies and publications jointly developed and protected by copyright, without having received prior written authorization from the other side.

### Paragraph 7

Funding for the development of collaborations in Paragraph 4 will be secured by the respective organizations, each for the part of its competence.

### Paragraph 8

This Technical Arrangement will come into effect on the date of last signature. This Technical Arrangement will remain in effect for a period of one year renewable automatically unless any of the Parties expresses its willingness to terminate it by written communication to be transmitted to the other Party with an advance notice of three (3) months.


Any dispute regarding the interpretation or application of this Arrangement will be resolved through direct consultations between the parties.


