REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PREPARATION OF CONFERENCE PAPERS

1. Conference papers of up to 10 pages in length will be accepted for publication in the conference proceedings.

2. Conference papers should be formatted as follows: A4 page size; text in Ukrainian or English, prepared in Microsoft Word using Times New Roman, 14-point font size, with 1.5 line spacing.

3. Page layout requirements: margins – left: 3 cm, right: 1 cm, top: 2 cm, bottom: 2 cm; pages must be numbered.

4. In the upper right corner of the first page (font: regular, without italics or underlining), the following information should be provided:

author's surname and initials;

academic degree and academic title;

name of the institution/organization;

author's ORCID;

author ID in Scopus or Web of Science Core Collection (if available).

5. The number of co-authors should not exceed three.

6. The title should be typed in uppercase letters, in bold font, without italics or underlining, centered on the page, without word hyphenation, and separated from the main text by one blank line above and below.

7. Numbering of formulas, figures, and tables within the abstract should be continuous throughout the text.

8. The reference list should be prepared according to the APA Style standards for formatting academic publications.

References should be arranged alphabetically by the surname of the author (or editor/compiler). If a source has no author, it should be listed alphabetically according to the first letter of its title.

If a cited source has a DOI, it must be provided.

In-text citations should be placed in parentheses and include the author's surname (or editor/compiler/ title of the source if no author is available), year of publication, and page number or page range, for example: (Pohorielov, 2025, p. 17).

9. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to reject materials that do not comply with the formatting requirements, lack scientific novelty or substantiated research findings, do not correspond to the theme of the event, or contain other inconsistencies with the selection criteria.
