



With the aim of forming a combat-ready mobilization reserve of the Armed Forces of Ukraine, comprehensive training students, education of military-professional, moral, psychological and patriotic qualities, fostering a sense of duty and readiness to defend Ukraine, as well as ensuring the realization of the right of citizens to equal opportunities in choosing a profession by acquiring additional knowledge, the Department of Military Training of the National Defense University of Ukraine conducts military training of Ukrainian citizens under the reserve officer training program to provide the Armed Forces of Ukraine with the necessary number of military trained citizens for military service and performance of military duty.

Citizens (men and women) who have or are obtaining a higher education degree not lower than a bachelor's degree and are fit for military service for health reasons and moral and business qualities undergo military training under the reserve officer training program on a voluntary basis.

The organization of military training is carried out in accordance with the requirements of the "Procedure for conducting military training of citizens of Ukraine under the reserve officer training program" of February 1, 2012, Nº 48, and the "Instruction on the organization of military training of citizens of Ukraine under the reserve officer training program" of December 14, 2015, Nº 719/1289 (with amendments), the Statutes of the Armed Forces of Ukraine, orders and directives of the Ministry of Defense of Ukraine, the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine.

Citizens undergo military training under a state order at the expense of the state budget or at the expense of individuals.

The National Defence University of Ukraine started training reserve officers in 2001.

In accordance with the Order of the Head of the National Defence Academy of Ukraine № 167 dated 13.02.2001 "On the organization of training of students under reserve officer programmes at the Faculty of Retraining and Advanced Training (part-time and external studies)", the training of students under the reserve officer programme was launched under the leadership of colonel in reserve Valerii Marchenko.

The next stage was the reorganization of the Faculty of Reserve Officers Training in accordance with the order of the Head of the The National Defence University of Ukraine named after Ivan Cherniakhovskyi № 126 "On Reorganization of the Department of Reserve Officers Training" dated 23.06.2015.

Reserve Colonel Vadym Martsenkivskyi, Candidate of Technical Sciences, Associate Professor, was appointed as the Dean of the Faculty.

In 2019, the Faculty of Reserve Officers Training was reformatted into the **Department of Military Training** of the National Defence University of Ukraine, headed by Colonel **Yevhen Kamalov**.

The further development of the Department of Military Training of the National Defence University of Ukraine has been entrusted to the Head of the Department of Military Training, Colonel **Volodymyr Hryniuk**, Hero of Ukraine, since October 2023.







In accordance with the order of the Head of the National Defence University of Ukraine Nº 59 "On the establishment of the Day of the Department of Military Training" dated 26.02.2021, 13 November 2001 was determined as the beginning of the training of Ukrainian citizens under the reserve officer training programme at the educational institution and was established as the "Day of the Department of Military Training".





MILITARY ACCOUNTING SPECIALTIES IN WHICH RESERVE OFFICERS ARE TRAINED:

- The use of mechanized units;
- The use of tank units;
- Organization of operation and repair of armored vehicles;
- Use of artillery units;
- Use of military units and subunits of anti-tank guided missile systems (ATGM);
- · The use of air assault units;
- The use of formations, military units and subunits of the Marines;
- Use of engineering and technical units;
- Use of engineering, road construction and urban planning units;
- Organization of fire safety;
- Mathematical and software support for the operation of automated systems, information security and cybersecurity systems;
- Organization of food, clothing, skipper and trade and household support;
- Organization of moral and psychological support.

Duration of training:

The Reserve Officer Training Program for a 4-month training program. The Reserve Officer Training Program for 1-year and 2-year training programs "military day method" (once a week)



- training of highly qualified reserve officers for the Armed Forces of Ukraine in accordance with a certain list of military specialties;
- selection of students for training in accordance with a certain list of military specialties;
- development of normative educational documents (Qualification Description, military training programs) together with the customer to organize training of reserve officers according to a certain list of military specialties;
- development of the material and technical base of the Department to ensure a high level of practical training of students in certain military specialties;
- improving the methodological skills of the scientific and pedagogical staff of the Department, teaching staff, improving the techniques, forms and methods of conducting all types of classes;
- conducting organizational, educational, informational, cultural and educational activities to foster students' commitment and service to the Ukrainian people;
- implementation of measures for digitalization of educational activities;
- conducting scientific, technological and innovative activities among students in order to acquire special competencies necessary for a future officer of the tactical level of management.







Military training consists of theoretical and practical military training courses, comprehensive practical classes on the course of primary military professional training and tactical medicine at the training center of the National Defence University of Ukraine and training camp.

After completing the training programme and passing the final exam, students undergoing military training take the Military Oath in a solemn ceremony in accordance with the procedure established by the Statute of the Internal Service of the Armed Forces of Ukraine.
